

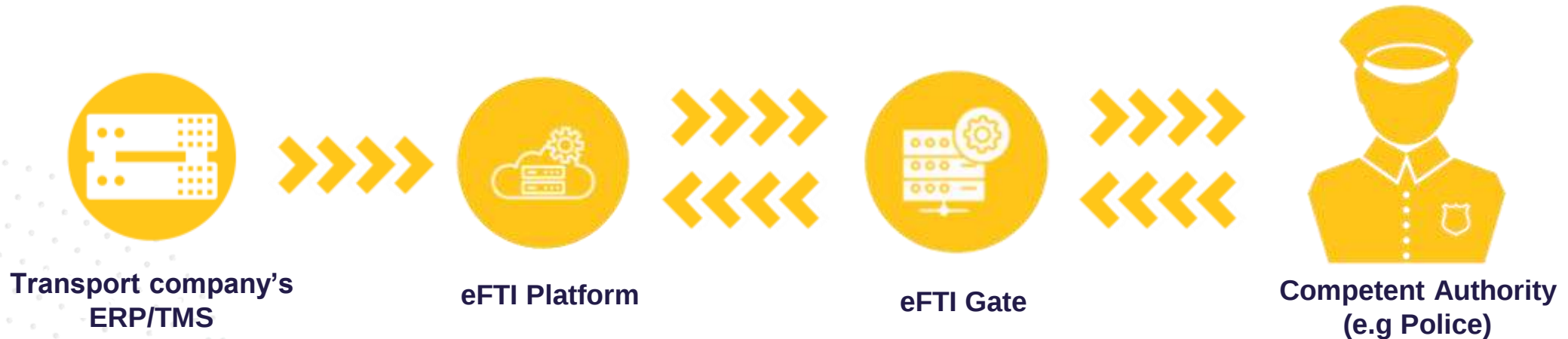

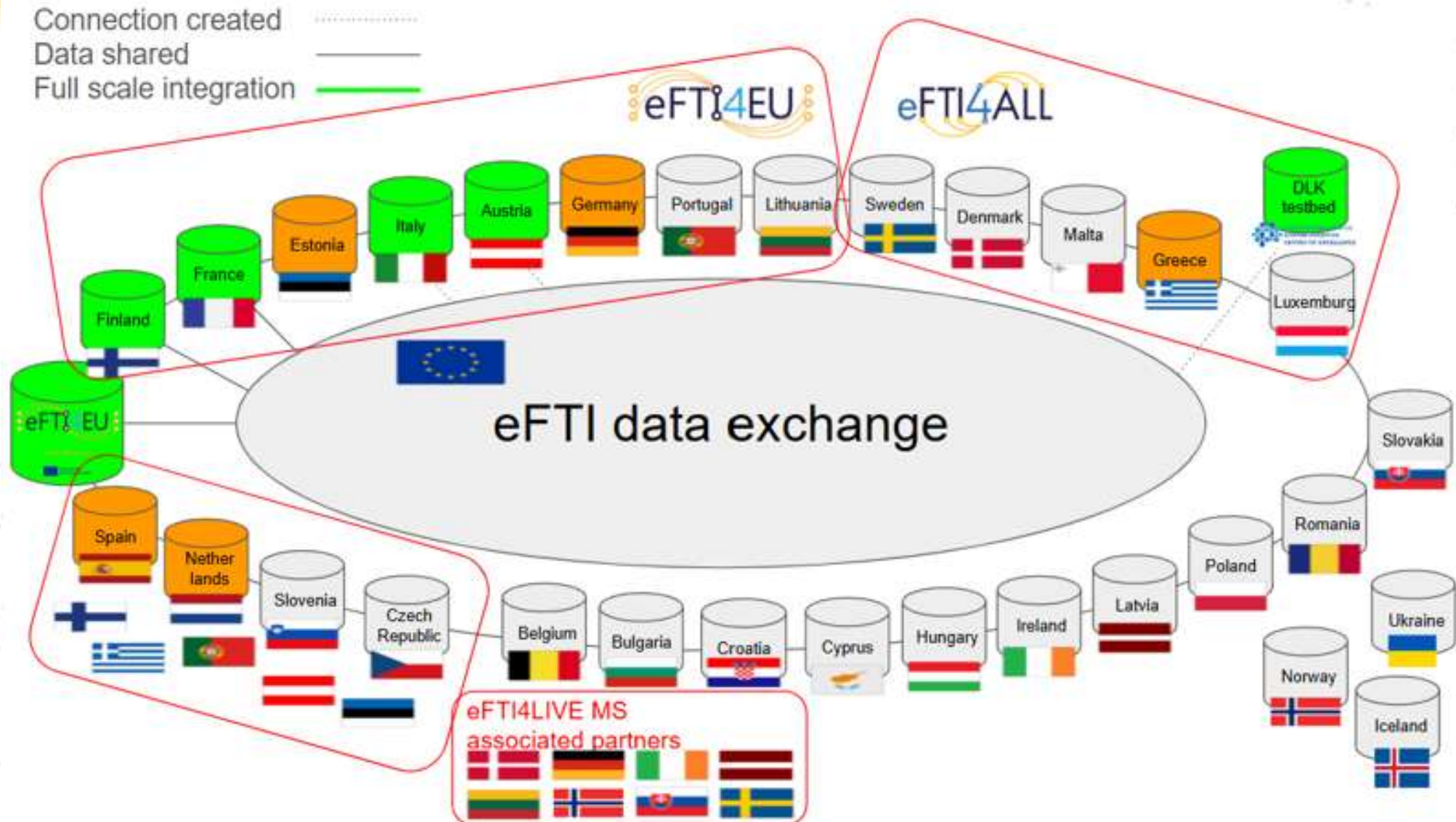
Ministry of Climate of Estonia

- **eFTI Platform** – an operating system, environment or **database** intended to be used for the processing and storing of **eFTI data**
- **eFTI Gate** – an intermediary between the **eFTI Platforms** and the **Competent Authorities**

How Estonia prepares for eFTI

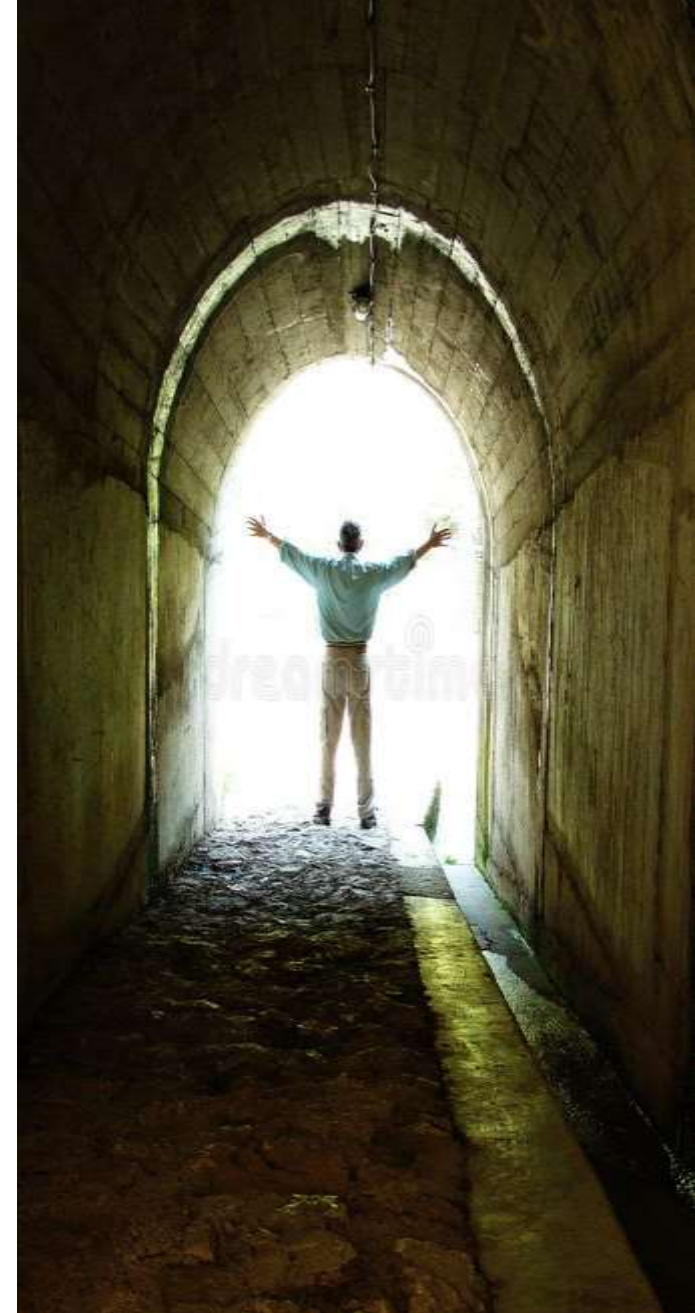
- 2020-2023 → Pilot projects in Baltics
- 2022 - Analysis of the operational model of the Estonian NAP (eFTI Gate) for electronic road transport consignments
 - Framework and Responsibilities
 - Technical Architecture and Interoperability
 - Budget and Sustainability
- 2022 – Support measure for the development of eCMR platforms
 - eCMR platforms → eFTI platform
- 2023 - 2026 → eFTI4EU Project

- 2023 - quarterly meetings/workshops/events bringing together ministries, competent authorities and private sector stakeholders
- 2024 – Mapping and analysis of the legal framework for implementing the eFTI
 - Focused on the legal aspects of national implementation
 - Recommendations for changes to national legislation
 - Preliminary timeline for implementation
- 2023-2024 – Dark times
 - New ministries were created and initial plans got mixed up
 - No responsible national IT center



- 2025 – Responsible IT centre
- 2025 – eFTI Gate Framework agreement
 - Autumn 2025 → development tender for the eFTI Gate
- End of 2025 - → Development works, testing (CA, eCMR platforms), implementation
- 2025 – Support measure for EO to integrate their systems (ERP/TMS, etc) with eCMR platforms
- 2025 - Support measure for EO to develop digital solutions for waste data management and for integrating waste reporting with the national system
- 2025 – 2029 → eFTI4LIVE
- What's next:
 - Automatic controls, e-waybills mandatory, etc?
 - Aim is to find ways to make it more useful to EO



Recommendations for MS (626 days left) – Let's make it happen!

- Make a roadmap and set a plan
- Identify stakeholders and involve them (Ministries/CA + potential service providers)
- Decide who will be responsible (incl. for legislative changes) and who will be the owner of the eFTI Gate
- **Find a MS that has made progress in developing an eFTI Gate**
 - Explore possibilities for cooperation
- **Cooperate with other Member States and look for opportunities to develop the eFTI Gate together**
 - Use the eFTI4EU project reference code as basis or start from the scratch
- **Get a (development) team and lead the process**
 - Use the eFTI4EU project reference code as basis or start from the scratch
- **Describe the solution and make a tender**
 - Use the eFTI4EU project reference code as basis or start from the scratch
- **Be creative and find your own way**
